Most of my performing days were when I was a teenager, and ever since graduating high school in 2011, my parents told me I had to study in post-secondary school for something else as a ‘back-up plan’. They were worried music was not going to sustain my future like an office job would. Not that they didn’t believe I could do it, but because they were scared the risk was not going to lead me to the reward. It took me about seven years of post-secondary school and personal growth to realize that music is the only true path for me. Once I graduated from my program in early 2020, I told my family that I must pursue music as my full-time career. I am lost without music and need to find myself again. ‘It’s now or never’, I said to myself. So here I am now.”

As a member of the Canadian Musicians Co-operative, Shir discovered her artist brand and identity through the 2020 Summer Emerging Artist Intensive Program. She has also developed a formal marketing plan and performed her original music multiple times per week on the Emerging Artist Online Livestreams.
